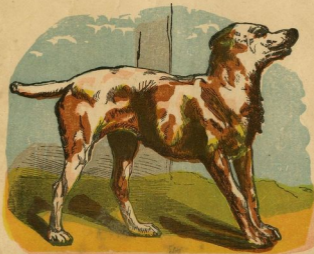

The poor Dog was laughing.

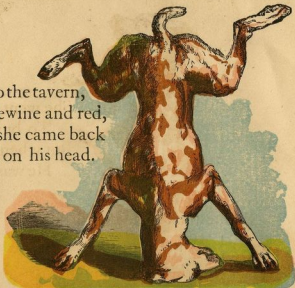

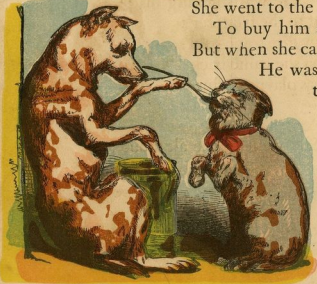
She took a clean dish,
